DELIVERY FORMAT

PEER-TO-PEER MODEL

- JFSA KNOW ABUSE[™] staff will train students within the school to be peer leaders who deliver the material to other students
- Peer leaders are students chosen by staff
- (3) 1 hour training sessions
- 90 minute presentation plus option for additional discussion time

COLLEGE INTERN MODEL

- Curriculum delivered by trained JFSA staff college interns
- Full version utilizing power point, group discussion and work sheets
 - (9) 45 minute sessions for High School
 - (7) 45 minute sessions for Middle School
- · Abbreviated version using power point
 - (4) 45 minute sessions for High School
 - (3) 45 minute sessions for middle school
